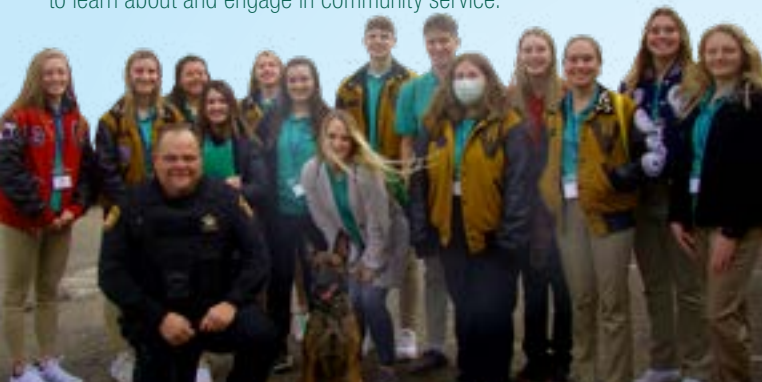


**Coshocton County Youth Leadership** provides the opportunity to learn about and engage in community service.
